- How can you use the same determinants that negatively impact your communities to positively overcome these barriers and help them achieve health equity?
- Policy decisions have long-lasting impacts on community health, from food deserts to the availability of healthcare services. What strategies can community leaders employ to effectively communicate the urgency of these issues to policymakers, thereby catalyzing positive change?
- Historically, community engagement has been a powerful tool for social change. How can community leaders best engage their constituencies in a sustained, meaningful way to tackle the systemic issues that contribute to health inequities?
