Allowable 501(c)(3) Activity

- Civic Engagement
 - Voter registration
 - Get-out-the-vote
- Public Education
 - Issue Advocacy
 - Candidate briefings
 - Candidate forums, debates and questionnaires



Non-partisan Get-Out-The-Vote

- Easier to conduct and legally safer than voter registration.
- Can use foundation grants.
- Vitally important for organizations focused on children.



Why is 501(c)(3) GOTV So Important?

- Child under 6 leads to 3-5% decrease in propensity to vote.
- Larger effects on low-income and BIPOC households.
- Due to "cost" of going to polls, not to decreased political awareness or interest.

- What other solutions can we brainstorm?



What are the Boundaries?

- Must be non-partisan: Can't support particular candidate or party
- Messaging: Safer to mention lots of issues to ensure your program is not aligned with any candidate.
- Targeting Either:
 - Everyone in the public; or
 - Historically underrepresented communities


